The Cub Scout Day Camp is a scouting experience program for Tigers (1st), Wolves (2nd), Bears (3rd), Webelos (4th), and Arrow of Light Scouts (5th) in the Western Slope. This program is also an open invitation for prospective scouts.

Scouts will arrive at camp with a responsible adult for activities ranging from BB Guns, Archery, fishing and mountain biking to crafts, challenge activities, and games.

This camp provides all program materials needed to complete and perform each activity. Some of the activities will help the scout with rank advancement requirements.

Please carpool as a group if possible as parking is limited.

All groups of attendees MUST meet the 1 : 4 adult to youth requirement. In addition, if your youth is a Tiger (1), you must meet a 1 :1 ratio for these youth. All adults will help their scouts through the activities throughout the program.

Early Registration: Prior to Friday, May 15th = \$10 per Cub Scout

Regular Registration: May 16th thru June 1st = \$40.00 per Cub Scout

REGISTRATION

- At registration, the registrar will verify that groups of attendees (I.e., packs) are complying with the 1:4 and 1:1 youth to adult ratios based on age.
- Please pre-register online for Day Camp at link above.
- Medical health forms A and B (found on registration site) are to be turned into the Day Camp Registrar upon signing in at the event. Please have these completed forms with you when you arrive.

General Information

- ✤ Full payment must be made prior to attending camp.
- ALL health forms must be completed and turned in to the Day Camp Registration at the event.
- ✤ Late registrations may be charged an additional fee.
- ♦ Optional parent package available for \$25.00 and Cub package available for \$15.00.
- All attendees must comply with the previously stated 1:4 and 1:1 adult to youth ratios.
- Youth and adults <u>need to bring a water bottle and a sack lunch each day</u>. All attendees should also dress appropriately for the weather forecast, like sunscreen and head gear. No open toe shoes. 'A Scout is prepared'
- Mark jackets, hats, food containers etc. with youth's name and pack number (if applicable).
- ✤ Any youth that is to be released from Day Camp prior to the end of the day <u>MUST</u> check out and fill out the release form before leaving. (included in this packet)
